Job Description (Duties Overview)

Under the supervision of the House Manager, as directed by Board policy and in conjunction with the Dorie's House team, the Youth Worker is responsible for supervising and coaching youth on an individual and group basis. This includes overall case management and case coordination activities of the youth served and as assigned by the House Manager or Executive Director.

- Maintain confidentiality as outlined in the SwYES Policies and Procedures Manual.
- Actively and effectively advocate to ensure needs of the individuals served are being met.
- Consistently use and adhere to SwYES Policies and Procedures to guide decision making and action.
- Demonstrate a team approach to implement program goals and direction.
- Participate in program evaluation.
- Establish working relationships with youth, organizational staff, partnering agencies and stakeholders based on respect, genuineness, trust and competence.
- Listen actively to input from youth and others and integrate or accommodate such input within your own practice.
- Perform responsibilities in an ethical manner and represent SwYES in a mature and conscientious manner.

- Demonstrate efficiency and effectiveness in use of work time in achieving performance goals.
- Role model positive interactive behaviour with youth and staff.
- Take initiative in engaging in professional development.
